Psalm 46: 1 – 3 (Pastor Sarah's Translation)

God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

- 2 Therefore we will not fear, though the narthex and sanctuary should change, though the mountains shake in the heart of the sea,
- 3 though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble with its tumult.

Change is coming! Does that phrase strike a little fear and trembling? It might, because change is never easy and change is not usually how we like to do things. But change is coming to St. John's, and in a lot of ways, it is very exciting!

We are well on our way in the renovation process! (Be sure to read Gareth P's detailed update!) Lots of things have been done that we can't see, but each step that we take brings us closer to much bigger, visible changes. And I'll be honest, I can't wait!

But that doesn't make change any easier to see. We all have memories that are tied to places in our buildings and we might not be excited to change those areas – but imagine the new memories we will make together in a beautiful, cleaned up space that is better able to serve our neighbors and one another. I can't wait!

There is still a lot of work to do before we begin demolition and see those visible changes. We will be doing a lot of cleaning out – watch for information on how you can help! We will also be talking about fundraising and how we can be supporting the project as individuals and as a congregation. (Have you committed to giving to the building fund? Are you able to give to help us meet our expenses and goals?)

I think that two important things we will have to be in the coming months are flexible and patient. We are all aware that projects like this sometimes have snags and delays – so we have to be patient and know that it will get done. We also have to be flexible with where we are worshipping and what is happening in our life together. Things might not go as planned and we have to be ready for that, knowing that worship will happen and the work will get done.

Please continue to pray for our church and those who are doing the work of this project. We have a wonderful future ahead of us and like I said, I can't wait to see what is to come. Be sure to watch for more updates and information to come!

Renovation update and property work day

Renovation Team Update: March 2024

The renovation team continues to make progress with the design and planning work behind the scenes:

- On March 20, we met with Pyramid (General Contractor) and KD3 (Architects) to review and select options for flooring, paint colors, countertop surfaces, hardware, ceiling tiles, and more. The samples will be available to see in the Parlor if you would like to take a look. We will have all new commercial-grade carpet squares installed in the new narthex as well as the sanctuary. We selected a vinyl plank tile option for the new bathroom and kitchen areas. All the new finishes will look great and totally transform the space!
- We will be meeting again with the design team to review the final mechanical and electrical drawings so Pyramid can put this out to bid to its subcontractors. We can also then move forward with permit applications to Shiremanstown Borough. As a reminder, the construction budget for Pyramid is \$660,000.
- We submitted zoning variance requests to Shiremanstown Borough for the new exit and exterior stairs to be built in the alley.
- We signed a contract with Susquehanna Organ for the new digital organ and pipe interface and connection to our current pipework. The total cost will be \$245,000, and we paid the initial 1/3 installment to get the work started. This will include a 10-year warranty. You can read more about the Allen Organ Model RL90 at www.allenorgan.com. Located in Macungie, PA, Allen is the largest organ builder in the world.

How can you help?


