

## Cemetery Report for July 2022

The month of July was an interesting month. We had someone storing their SUV, Trailer and 4 Wheeler on the Cemetery Property. They were also using our property to run the 4 wheeler. On June 30<sup>th</sup>, I called the Hampden police, Pastor Sarah and Steve Sloat came out to the cemetery to also meet with the police. It was decided that a certified letter, sent from us informing the person that they were not allowed to store or use our property for their recreational activities was needed. We sent the certified letter on the 30<sup>th</sup>. As the Cemetery is considered private property, we were informed by Hampden Township Police that we had the right to have the vehicles towed. On July 1<sup>st</sup>, I had Jerry's towing from Carlisle come and tow the vehicles, along with their chairs, fire pit and other items. Jerry's did not charge us for the towing as it was considered abandoned property.

We had one cremation burial for Marian Logan on July 9<sup>th</sup>.

Cemetery Committee is currently considering looking for a grave digger / ground's keeper for the cemetery next year.
