Neither he nor the PSP were able to find the tire. Apparently, the tire picked up speed, hit the retaining wall on 581 (at the bridge going over St. John's Rd) jumped across traffic, flying into the cemetery, hitting the one base, then the headstone next to it before coming to a rest two rows behind the headstones. Headstone Was fixed.
